

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **September 15th to September 28th 2024**

Sunday, September 15th: Called out for tree blocking road on Mooney Hill.

Monday, September 16th: Finished Installing last swing at preschool playground. Removed all swim lines from beaches. Got truck 9 and truck 2 inspected. Removed town boat from lake and washed.

Tuesday September 17th: Cleaned up brush at Lyman and Gilman Cemetery. Roadside mowing on boat ramp. Cleaned beaver screen on Lead Mine Rd. and cleaned clogged culvert. Two trips to Mount Carberry. Purchased 2 18" culverts from Paris Farmers Union and delivered them to Downs Road.

Wednesday, September 18th: Replaced Culvert on Downs Road. Roadside mowing on Bickford Road.

Thursday, September 19th: Removed over 60 ton of glass from transfer station. Roadside mowing on Bickford Road. Put a piece of playground equipment in playground for school. Picked up zero turn lawnmower from United AG & Turf. Brought 416 backhoe from transfer station to lower garage.

Friday, September 20th: Moved containers around at transfer station to set up for weekend. Cleaned beaches and mowed Town Hall. Roadside mowing Bickford Road. Began cleaning ditches and culverts on Dr. Mudd Road. 1 trip to Mount Carberry. Cleaned and serviced truck 2.

Saturday, September 21st: Winterized town boat.

Wednesday, September 25th: Finished cleaning ditches on Goe Hill Road. Replaced teeth on mulching head on Volvo excavator. Brought town boat to Wards boat shop for winter covering. Started cleaning lower garage.

Thursday, September 26th: Rainy day. Cleaned lower garage. Replaced bed chain on truck 9. Mandatory drug testing was performed. One load of trash was taken to Mount Carberry.

Friday, September 27th: Put truck 9 back together. Painted field hockey goals. Upper garage yard clean up. Two loads of metal were taken to Rickers Auto Salvage. One load of recyclables was taken to Eco-Maine.

Saturday, September 28th: Picked up town boat from Wards boat shop and returned to town garage.

Dig out culvert on Bickford Road.
High Limb Fox Road before winter.
Fix Glines Hill culvert header.
High limb library parking lot.
Fill potholes on East Shore Drive.
