Sunday, November 10th:

Monday, November 11th: Veteran's Day Holiday

Tuesday, November 12th: Checked all roads. Showed Jim and John all plow routes. Removed and cleaned tree from North Division Road. Brought truck 2 to Londonderry, Donovan Equipment for hydraulic repair. Worked on IWorq.

Wednesday, November 13th: Cut brush away from guardrails on Peak Vista Lane. Repaired Billy Goat leaf sucker by repairing pull string and adding a battery box. Picked up leaves at Gilman Cemetery. Two trips to Mount Carberry and cleaned truck 2.

Thursday, November 14th: Picked up and removed leaves at Historical Society and Lyman Cemetery. Had to do some minor repairs to the leaf box. Cut brush and cleaned up behind the lower garage. Brought truck 14 to Frechette Tire for new tires. SWOT training for Dave 12.5 hours.

Friday, November 15th: Cleaned up around garage and fire station. Started putting mowing equipment away for winter. Drained used oil transport tank into upper garage furnace. Swapped containers at transfer station. Finished SWOT training for license renewal.
