

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **November 24th to December 7th 2024**

Sunday, November 24th: Heavy winds

Monday, November 25th: Checked all roads and removed fallen trees and limbs. Worked on trucks and plows preparing them for pending storm. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry

Tuesday, November 26th: Cleaned up garages to make sure we could fit all trucks inside. Checked roads due to freezing rain. One trip was made to Mount Carberry. Cleaned and serviced truck 2. Repaired spinner on truck 9.

Wednesday, November 27th: Put plows and sanders in trucks and loaded them to prepare for Thursday storm.

Thursday, November 28th: Thanksgiving Holiday Plowed snow 11:00 a.m. until midnight.

Friday, November 29th: Cleaned up after storm, fire hydrants, parking lots, sanding back roads. Truck 11 had broken down the previous night on Allard Hill. We repaired it on site and brought it back to the garage.

Saturday, November 30th: Checked roads and pushed snowbanks back on North Division Road with Truck 12. Worked on Truck 3 plow flipping rubber edge and worked on truck 14 sander.

Sunday, December 1st:

Monday, December 2nd: Checked roads and pushed snowbanks back on North Division Road with Truck 12. Worked on Truck 3 plow flipping rubber edge and worked on truck 14 sander. Closed Glines Hill Road for season. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry and scheduled a new windshield to be installed on truck 3.

Tuesday, December 3rd: One trip to Mount Carberry. Cleaned truck 2 and serviced demo container. Worked on truck 14 sander and put steel edged plows on truck 3 and 10. Went over Allard Hill plow route and pushed back some. Went to Windy Ridge and Napa for parts. Repaired left front tire on 920 loader and serviced 920 loader.

Wednesday, December 4th: Pushed back on East Madison and the Hills Routes. Sanded some of the dirt roads. Got trucks cleaned up and loaded and ready for impending storm.

Thursday, December 5th: Plowed snow from 3:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Friday, December 6th: Sanded roads and storm clean up

Fix Glines Hill culvert header.
Fill potholes on East Shore Drive.
